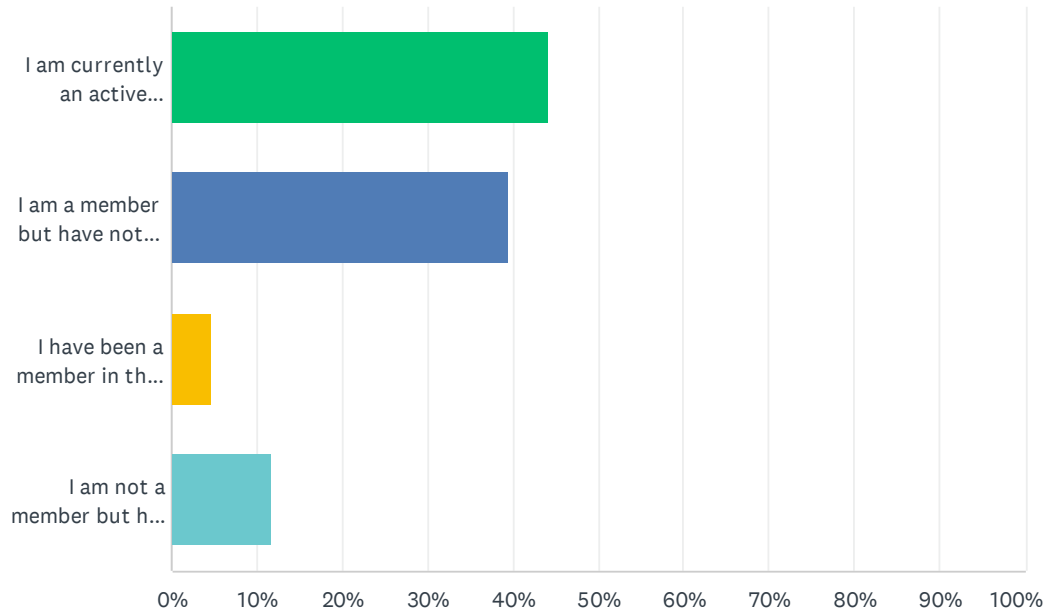


Q1 What is your current club membership status with the Person County Beekeepers Association (PCBA)?

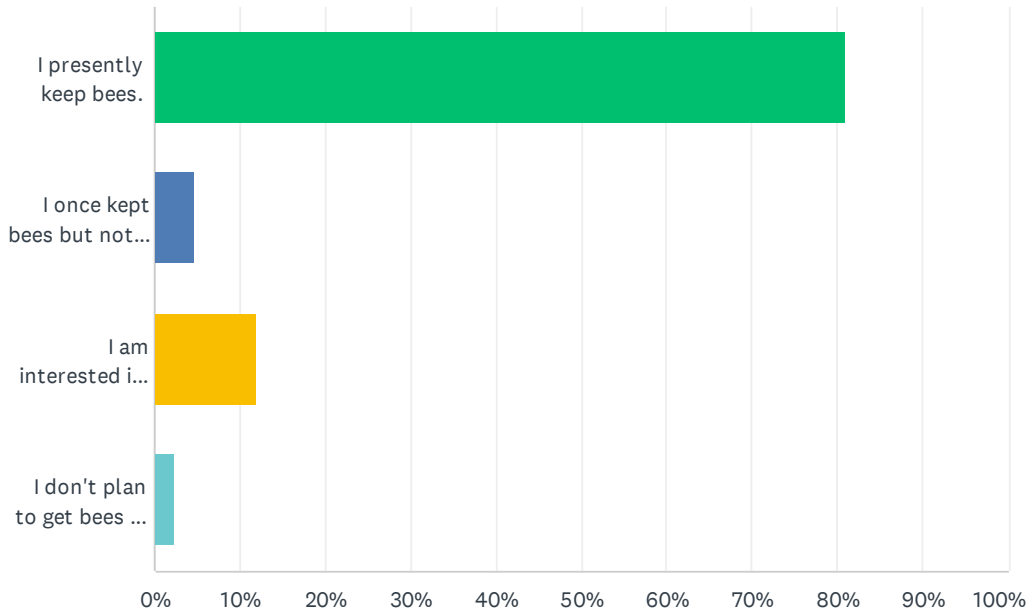

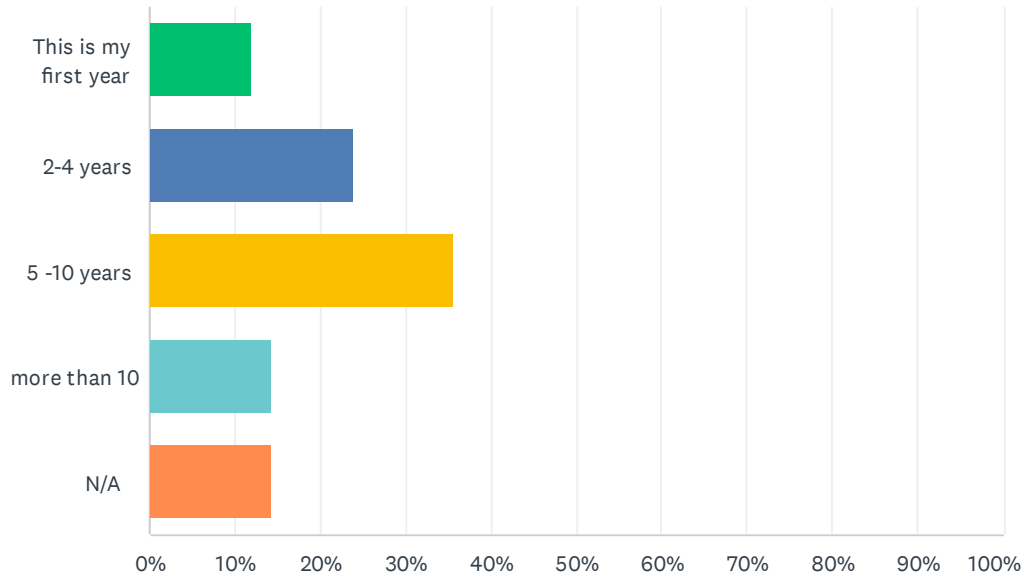

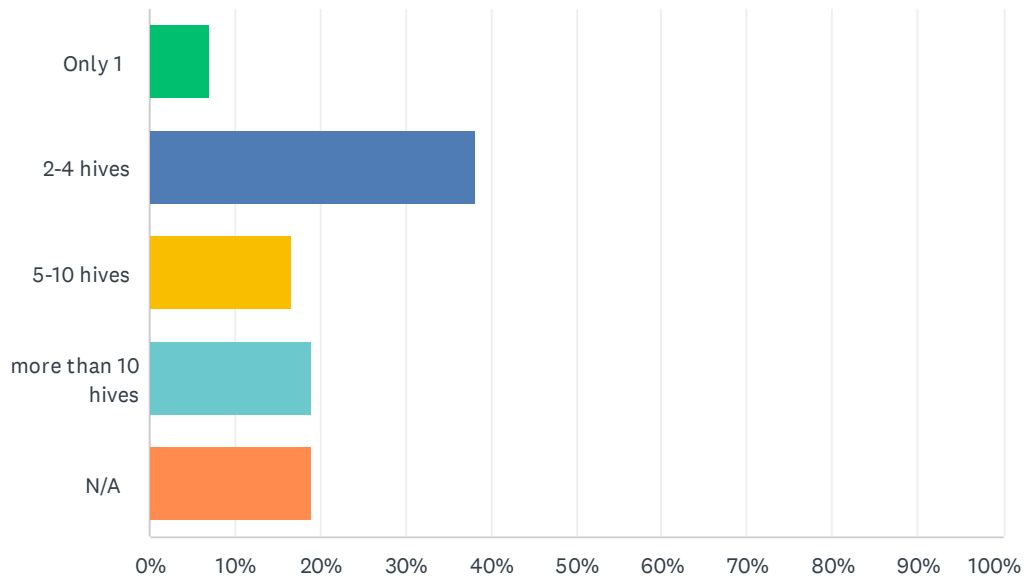

Q4 How many hives do you have going into winter of 2022?

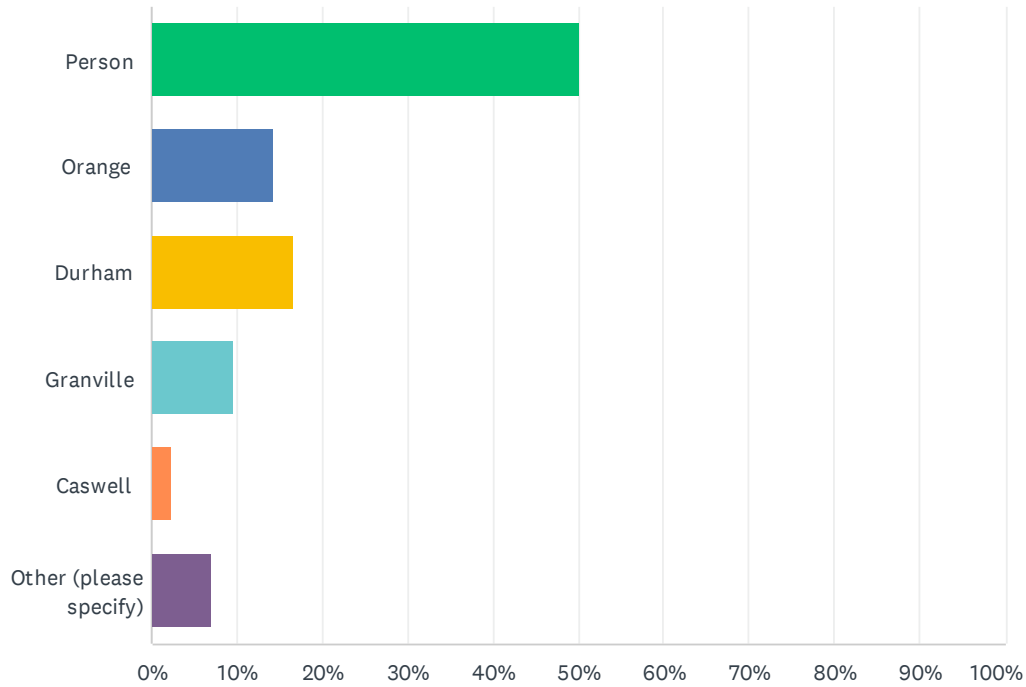

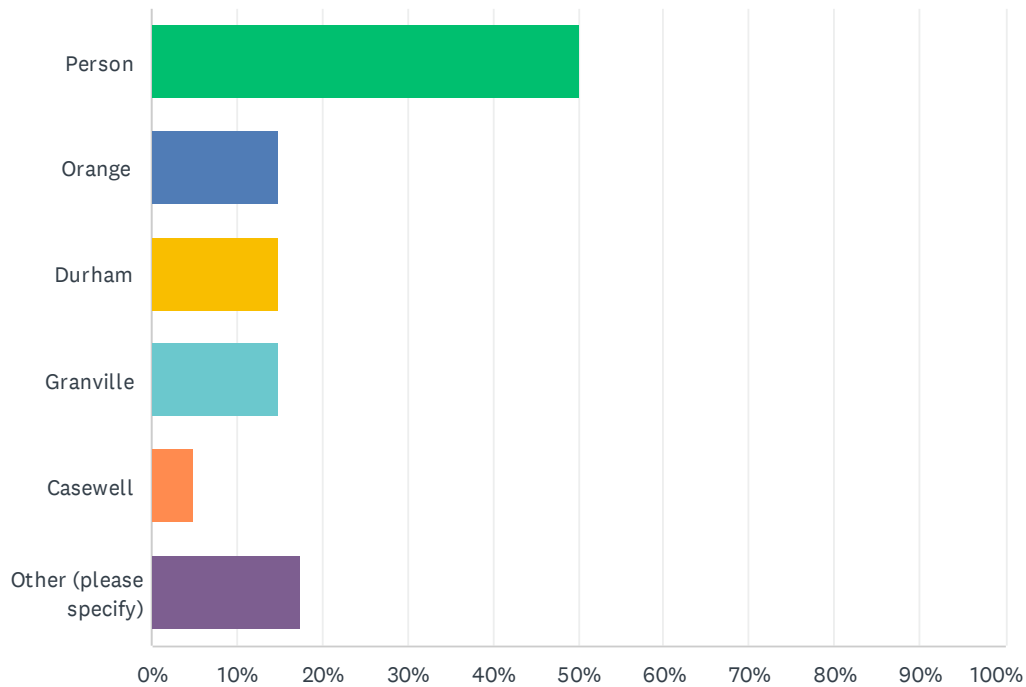

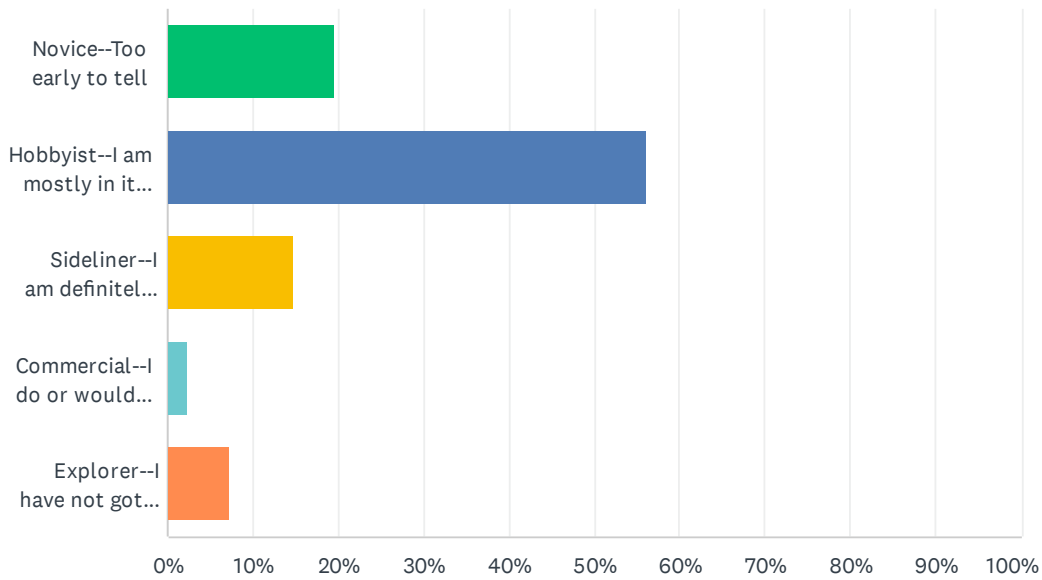

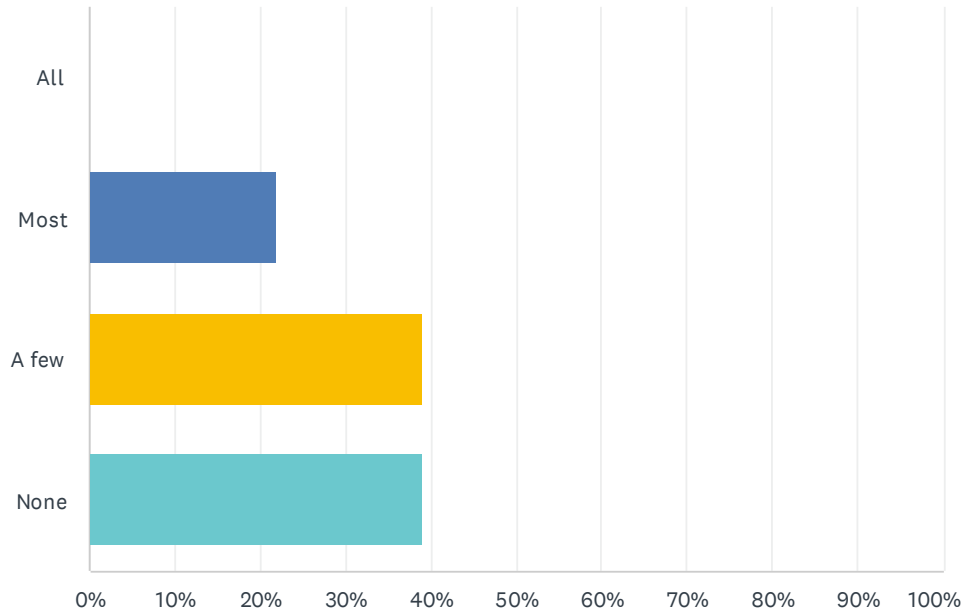

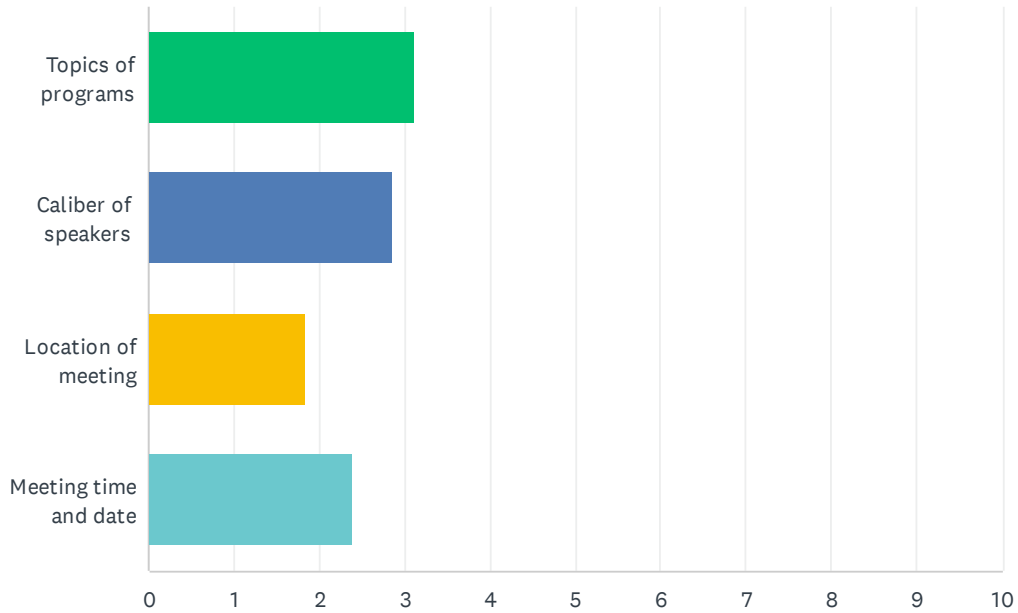

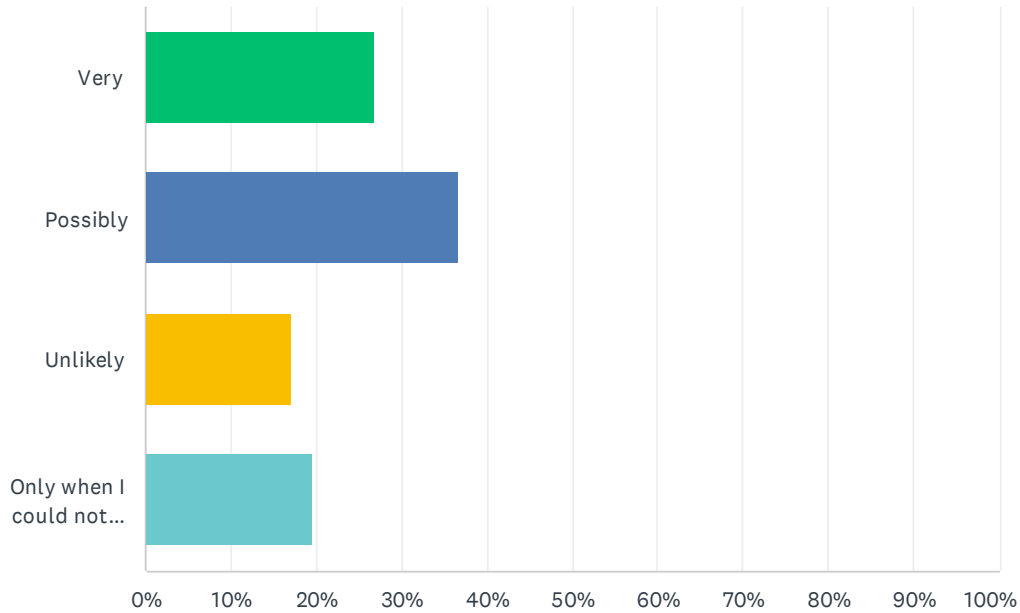

Q10 How likely is it that you would attend monthly meetings via a live streaming service?

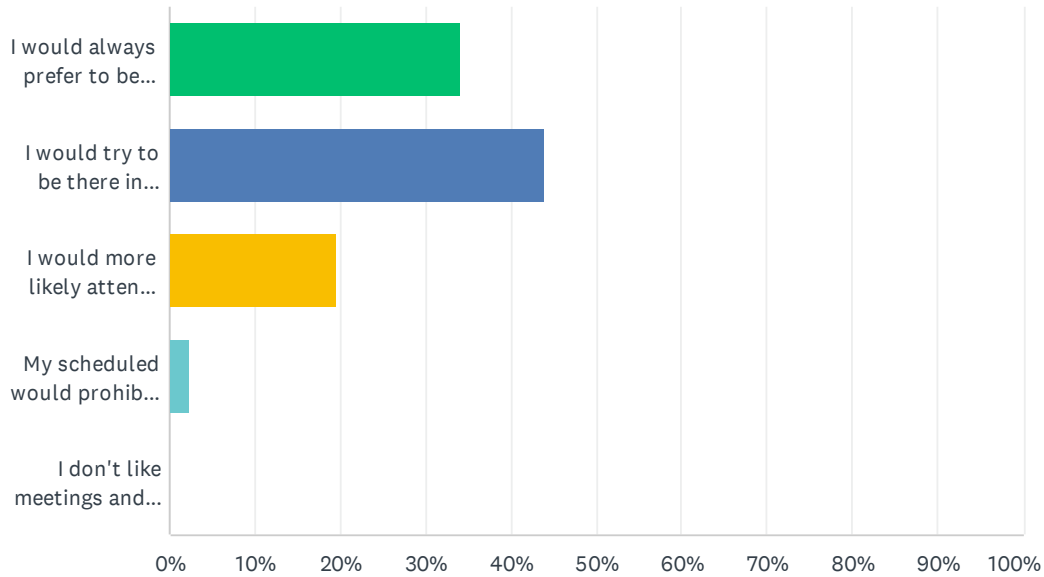

Q11 Given the choice of attending in person or by live stream, which is likely your preferred choice?

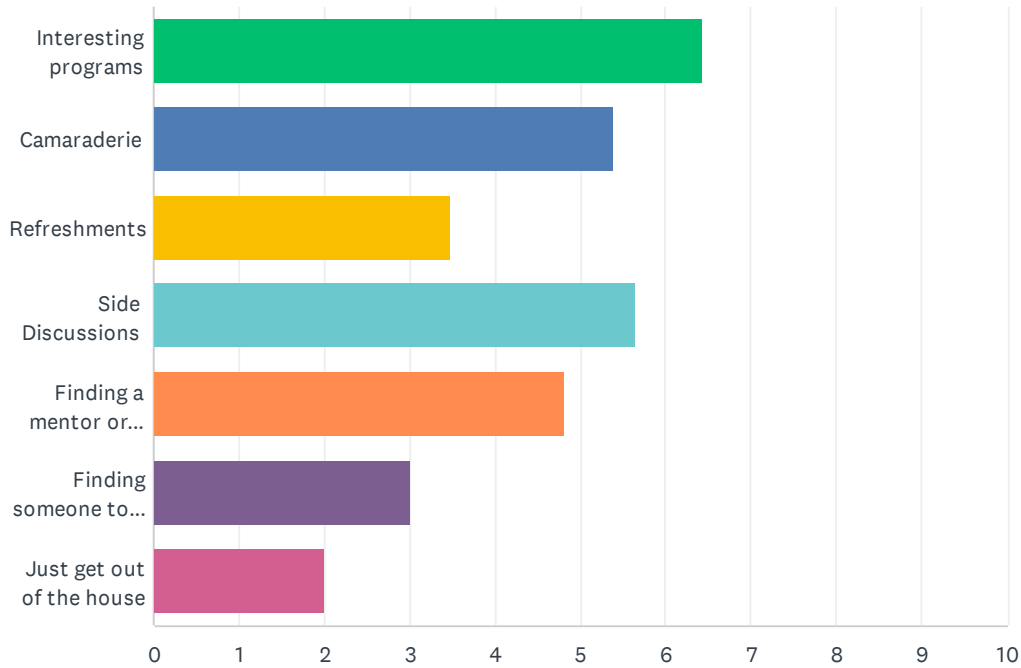

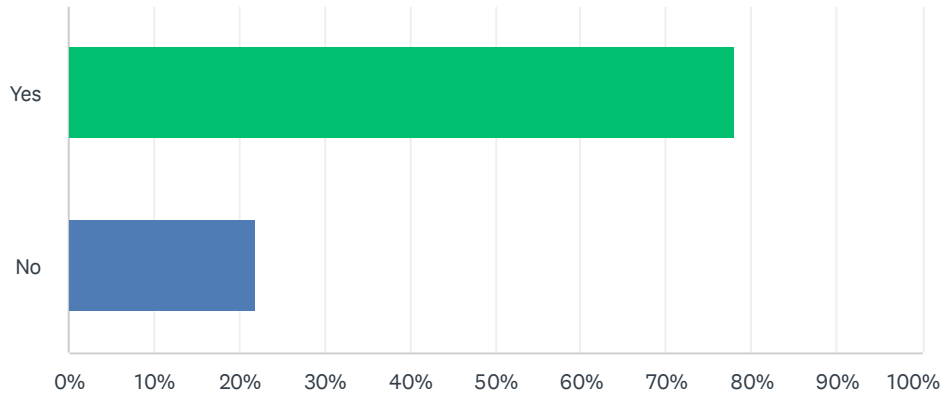

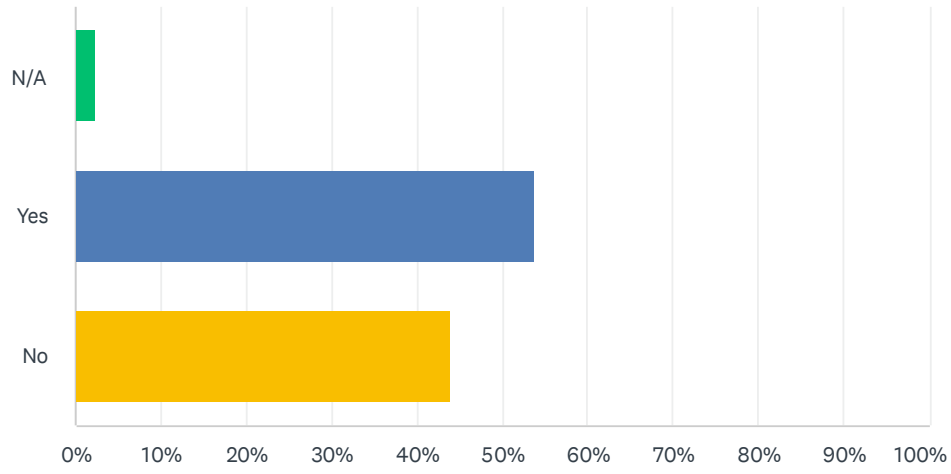

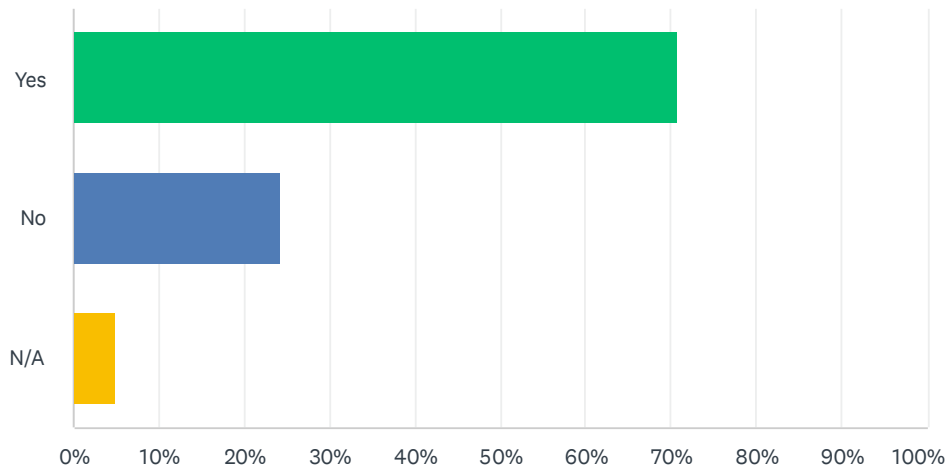

Q15 Do you understand the purpose of the community apiary?

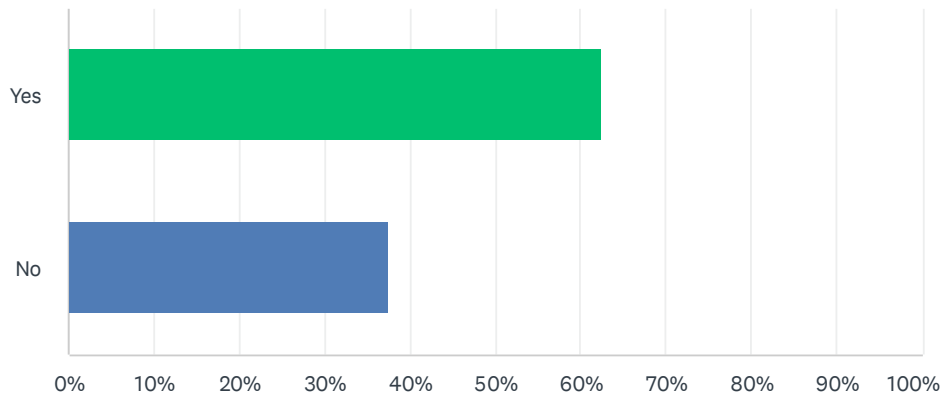

Q16 Would you consider using the community apiary if you knew how?

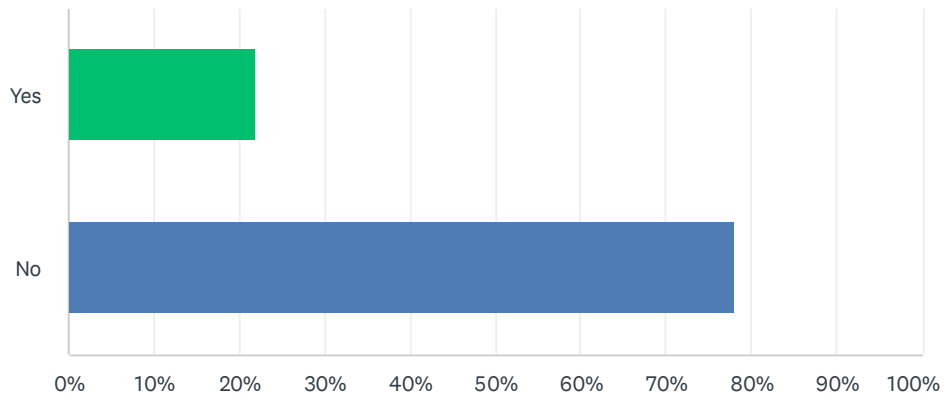

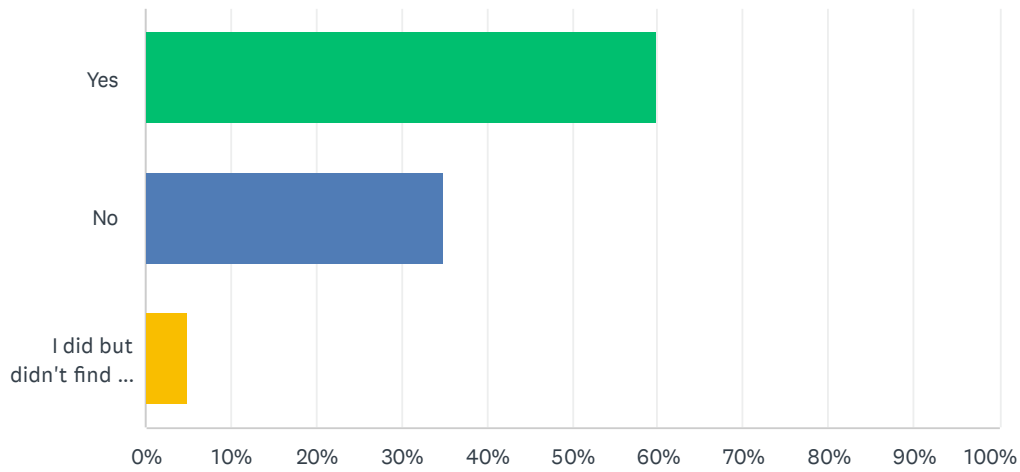

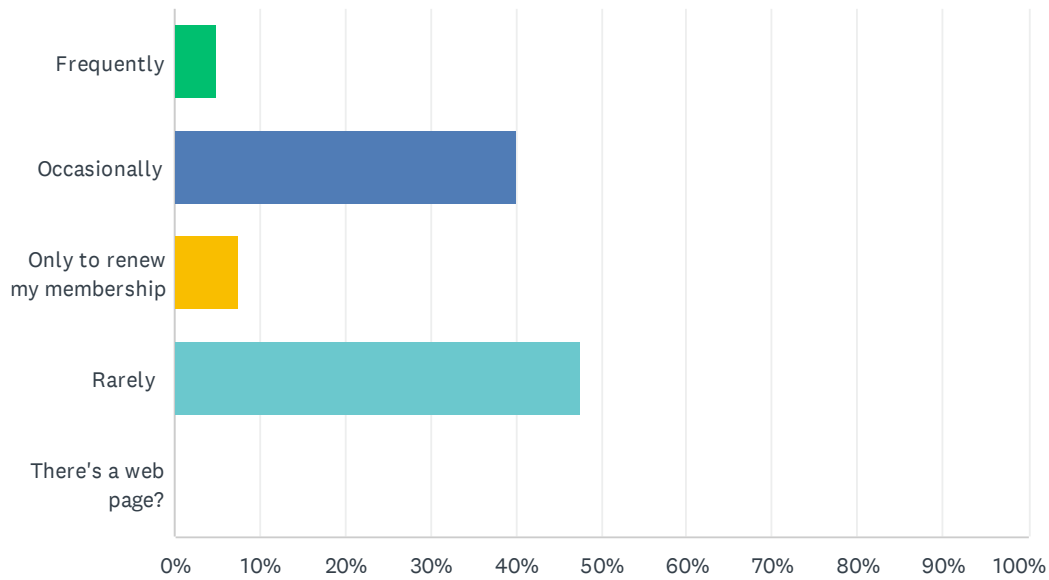

Q20 How frequently do you visit the PCBA web page?

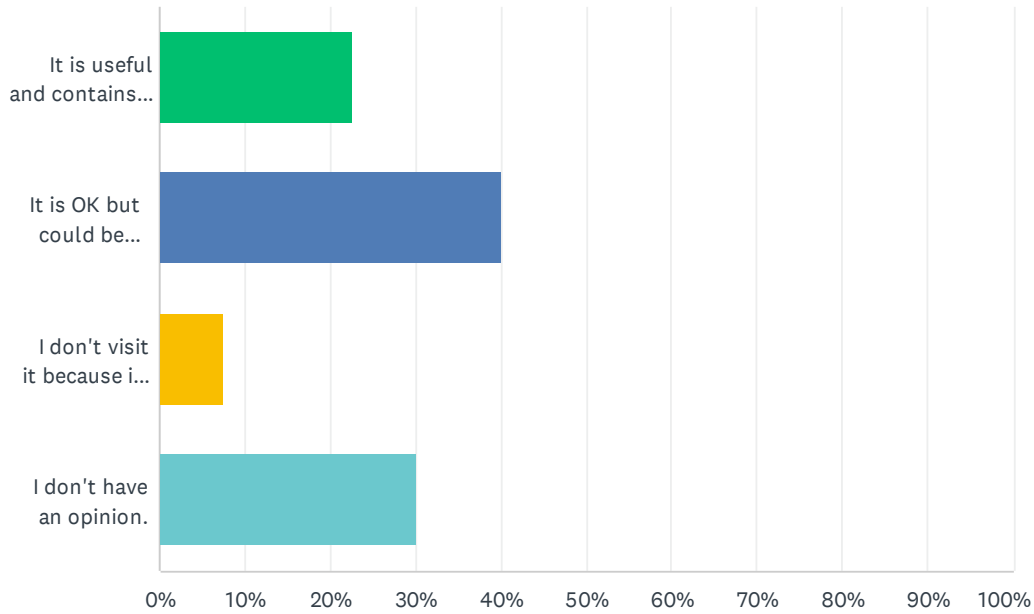

Q21 How would you rate the PCBA website?

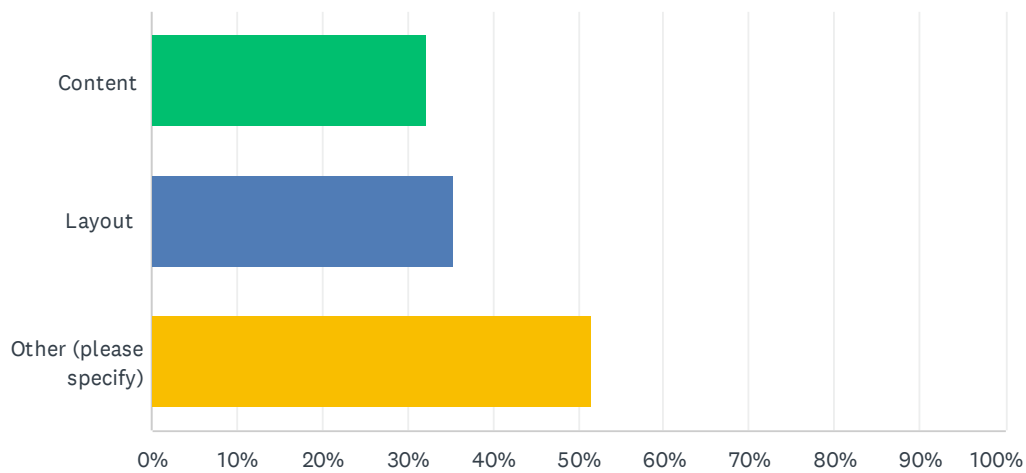

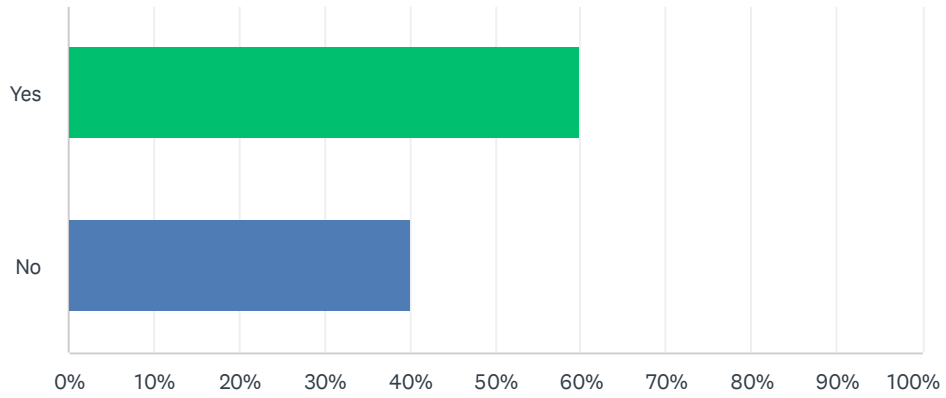

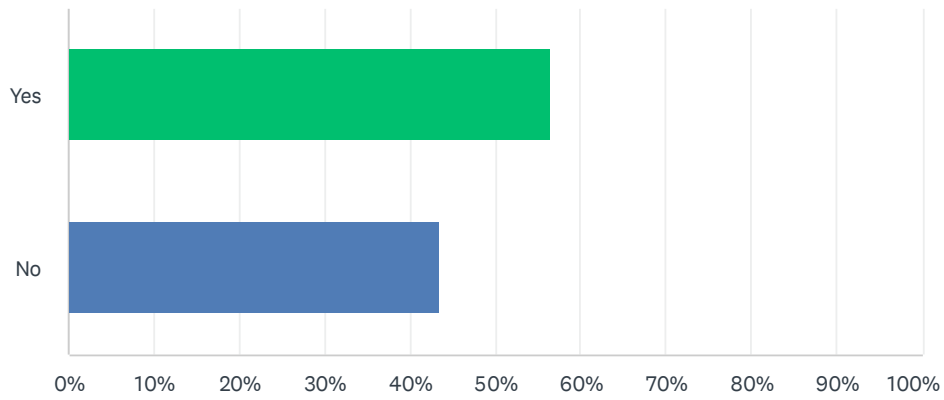

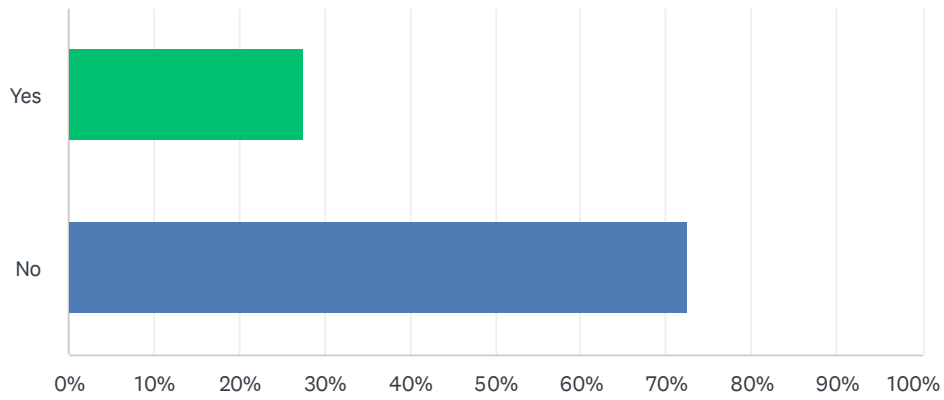

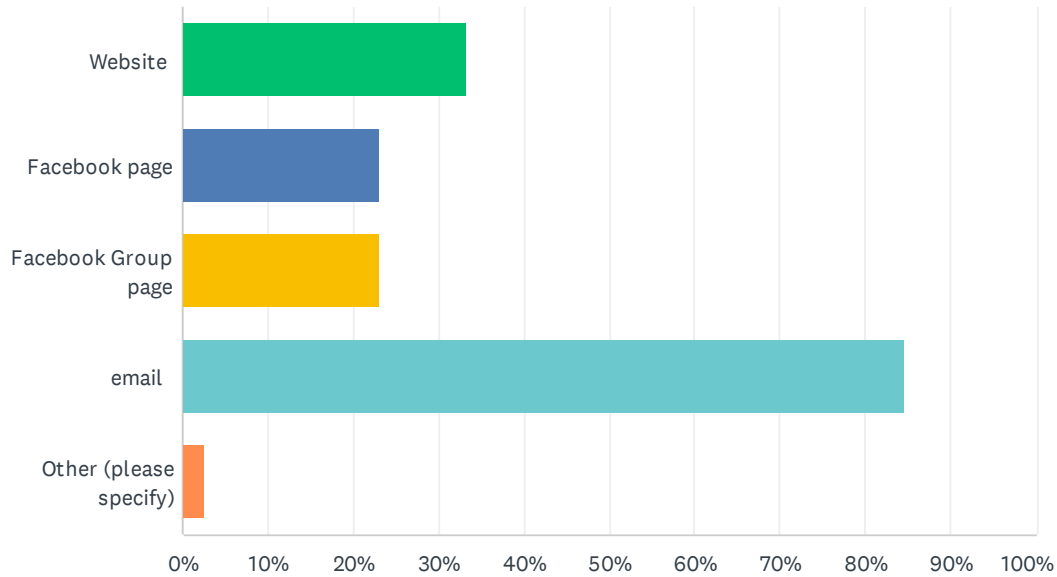
